Swim Test Make-Ups	Need another chance to complete your swim classification? Certified aquatics staff will be available to help Scouts finish or improve their swim test in a safe and encouraging environment. Low physical difficulty with basic swimming ability required.
Free Swim	Cool off and enjoy open time at the waterfront during Free Swim! Scouts can relax, swim with friends, and enjoy camp's aquatics area under staff supervision. Physical difficulty is low to moderate depending on activity level.
Kayak Award	Take to the water and build confidence in a kayak while learning paddling skills, safety, and maneuvering techniques. This adventure is perfect for Scouts who enjoy being active on the water and want to work toward the Kayaking BSA Award. Moderate physical difficulty. Must be a Swimmer to complete.
Kayak Fishing	Experience the excitement of fishing from a kayak while exploring camp's waterways. Scouts will learn basic kayak handling and fishing techniques while enjoying a unique outdoor adventure. Moderate physical difficulty with basic swimming skills recommended. Must be a Swimmer to complete.
SUP Award	Test your balance and paddling skills with Stand-Up Paddleboarding. Scouts will learn water safety, paddle techniques, and board control while working toward the SUP Award. Moderate physical difficulty with lots of fun on the water.
Fishing Fun	Whether you are a beginner or experienced angler, Fishing Fun is a relaxing way to enjoy the outdoors while learning casting, baiting, and fishing basics. Scouts may even reel in a great camp story along the way. Low physical difficulty.
Pulp and Paper Merit Badge	Discover how everyday paper products are made and explore the science and technology behind the paper industry. Scouts will participate in hands-on activities while learning about recycling, manufacturing, and conservation. Low physical difficulty.
Nature Hike	Explore the outdoors on a guided hike through camp trails and natural areas. Scouts will discover local plants, wildlife, and ecosystems while enjoying fresh air and scenic views. Moderate physical difficulty depending on trail conditions.

Tomahawk meets at the tomahawk range across the road from the shotgun range. LaPorte Archery meets at the Archery Range.

Rappel	Experience the thrill of descending down a climbing tower under the guidance of trained instructors. Scouts will learn proper rappelling techniques, equipment use, and safety procedures while building confidence. Moderate physical difficulty.
